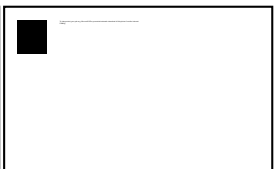
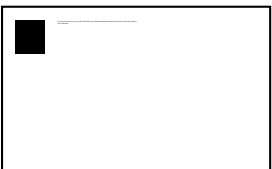
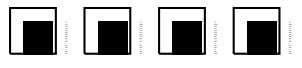
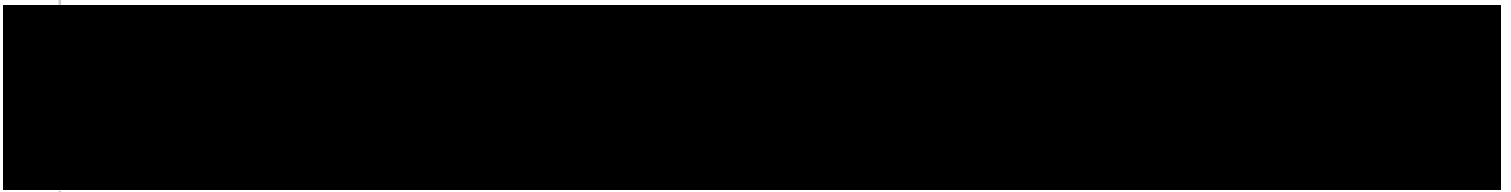
The swept path analysis, although very vague in its context to the existing site surrounds appears to be acceptable providing it can be successfully implemented in the application site conditions.
